

🗨️ **WHAT TO PRAY | Using each point below as a springboard to bring daily focus to our talking with God.**

- 🙏 **MON 4th, 11th, 18th, 25th: Devoted Disciples.** *Passionately and purposefully following Jesus.*
 - Today we pray for... An ever growing desire and passion for time set aside for prayer and the word that fuels and directs our daily walk; each step in line with God's plan and purpose and empowered by The Holy Spirit.
- 🙏 **TUES 5th, 12th, 19th, 26th: New Birth.** *Equipped to Show and Tell the Good News.*
 - Today we pray for... Each of us to be caught afresh with God's compassion for the lost that leads to salvation in our daily interactions and our more organised outreach initiatives (Mumstop, Familystop and Dadstop, Community Cafe, Rachel's Table, Hygiene Bank, Pebbles, Food Bank).
- 🙏 **WEDS 6th, 13th, 20th, 27th: Kingdom Culture.** *Generous, servant hearted, transformed not conformed.*
 - Today we pray for... God's Word and Spirit to shape our lives so that we are not *conformed* by those around us but are *transformers* of those around us.
- 🙏 **THUR 7th, 14th, 21st, 28th: Family & Fellowship.** *A growing family investing in relationship together.*
 - Today we pray for... Deepening and strengthening of covenant relationships with those in the LRC church family and increasing opportunities to begin and strengthen relationships with those in the wider 'Big C' Church family.
- 🙏 **FRI 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th: Supernatural Power.** *In many different settings in many different ways.*
 - Today we pray for... The Holy Spirit to be at work in us and through us in the ways we read in 1 Cor 12:4-11, 1 Cor 13 & Gal 5:16-26
- 🙏 **SAT 2nd, 9th, 16th, 23rd, 30th: Sunday's Coming.** *We are a royal priesthood, ready and expectant.*
 - Today we pray for... readiness ahead of what God will do among His gathered people tomorrow. We are consecrated, called out and coming together.
- 🙏 **SUN 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th: Thanksgiving.** *God is good.*
 - Today we praise and give thanks for God's goodness, faithfulness and loving kindness that never fails.

💡 **WAYS OF PRAYING | Using the following 4 different ways of praying this month...**

Talking To God 🗨️ Using the pre-written words of prayers, psalms, scriptures and songs to talk to God.

💡 **DAILY IDEA:** *Pray Matthew 6:9-13, Psalm 23, Psalm 139, the words of 'I Exalt Thee' or something else.*

Talking With God 🗨️ Using our own words for gratitude, lament and to ask of God in petition and intercession.

💡 **DAILY IDEA:** *Give thanks for 3 things each evening. Pray for breakthrough for the same person each morning.*

Listening To God 🎧 Attuning our ears to hear God (to listen and obey) as we quietly wait in His presence.

💡 **DAILY IDEA:** *Focus on a short bible passage, read it slowly, ask the Holy Spirit to speak and listen as He does.*

Being With God 🌿 Contemplative, wordless prayer that is about receiving His love and offering ours in return.

💡 **DAILY IDEA:** *Spend a few quiet, still minutes focussed on God. Simply be with Him and let Him love you.*

🙏 **PEW FOCUS: KNOW, GROW, SHOW** 🙏

Whether In Life Groups, families, with friends or in our own time, let's set aside an **hour of power** during the 1st week of November to pray as follows...
